## Summer 2012, What I Need to Know

- Your summer Cost of Attendance (see chart below) represents the maximum amount of financial aid, scholarships, grants, loans, and other resources that I can receive for the semester. Your Cost of Attendance is made up of both direct (tuition, on-campus housing, health insurance, and fees) and indirect (off-campus housing, books and supplies, loan fees, and transportation) costs and does not only reflect those charges that will appear on your Berklee bill.
- You can monitor the status of your financial aid awards online at **my.berklee.net** by clicking on *Student Services > My Finances > My Aid > 2012SU*. “Pending” aid and loans cannot be used to check-in purposes and will not be deducted from your bill. If aid is pending, you should check *My Documents* to verify that the Office of Financial Aid has received all requested materials from you.
- Summer bills will be mailed on April 23<sup>rd</sup> (March 15<sup>th</sup> for entering students). Additionally, you can view your bill online at **my.berklee.net** under *Student Services > My Finances > View My Statement*. Tuition bills are due in full by May 18th. If you pay later than this date, a \$250 Late Payment Fee will be added to your account.
- You should regularly monitor your ability to Check-In for summer 2012 online at **my.berklee.net** under *Check in and Orientation > Online Check-In*. Online check-in begins on May 20th and ends on May 25th. If you check-in later than May 25th, a \$250 Late Check-In Fee will be added to your account.
- If you plan to enroll for fewer than twelve credits, your aid eligibility may change. *Your summer aid may be revised to reflect your enrollment status when Add/Drop ends on June 6th.*
- The first round of summer refund checks will be available after the end of the Add/Drop period. You can confirm whether or not you qualify for a refund check online at **my.berklee.net** under *Student Services > My Finances > View My Statement*.
