

MUSIC THERAPY EQUIVALENCY PROGRAM

This curriculum assumes that the entering student completed all of the requirements for a baccalaureate degree in music or music education from an accredited institution. It further assumes the following: that the student has taken a 30-credit general education program, including General Psychology and another social science elective; specific skills in conducting, arranging and other AMTA music competencies have been completed prior to enrollment. Deficiencies in any of these areas must be taken in order to apply to CBMT to sit for the National Board Certification Examination. We will require a 16-month residency before the student begins Music Therapy Internship.
